3. You can filter based on book lists and award lists.


Your filters will be combined; e.g., if you choose *Middle Grades* and *Historical Fiction*, you will find books that match both filters.

Each time you select, the number in parentheses is the number of books available if you select this filter.


At any time, you can click *All books* at the top of the selection box to cancel all filters.
